Permelia Hallmark

Permelia Hallmark was born about 1823 in Georgia. It is unknown what her maiden name is, or who her family is. She married Prewitt Hallmark in Houston County, Republic of Texas about 1837. Permelia and Prewitt had seven children, the last born in 1855, the year Permelia was listed as a widow on her older childrens' scholastic record. Shortly after the record was taken, Permelia moved the family to Bastrop County. An April 1857 license records her second marriage, to John Apling in Gonzales County. The 1860 Caldwell County, Texas census lists Permelia and her husband living in Lockhart with her youngest Hallmark child, as well as two young Apling daughters. Apparently widowed again, Permelia married James Redford in Gonzales County, Texas on October 24, 1872, but was living with her daughter's family as "Permelia Aplin" on the 1880 Fayette County census. The 1900 Bastrop County census again sees Permelia living with her daughter's family, after which she is gone without a trace.
