

Richard Henry Hallmark



Richard Henry Hallmark was born January 30, 1785 in Knox County, Tennessee to George C. and Leannah Mynatt Hallmark. By 1807 he was in Roane County, Tennessee, where he married Mary Ann Prewitt. By 1808 the family had moved to Alabama, where they resided before migrating to Houston County, Republic of Texas, before October 1836. In 1844 Richard received a 1280 acre land grant in Bell (now Coryelle) County. Many of Richard Hallmark's family migrated between Houston and Bastrop Counties, and several participated in the Battle of San Jacinto in the Texas Revolution. Richard and his wife Mary Ann lived in Hallmark Prairie (now Jeddo), Bastrop County, Texas toward the end of their lives, where Richard died January 30, 1854.
